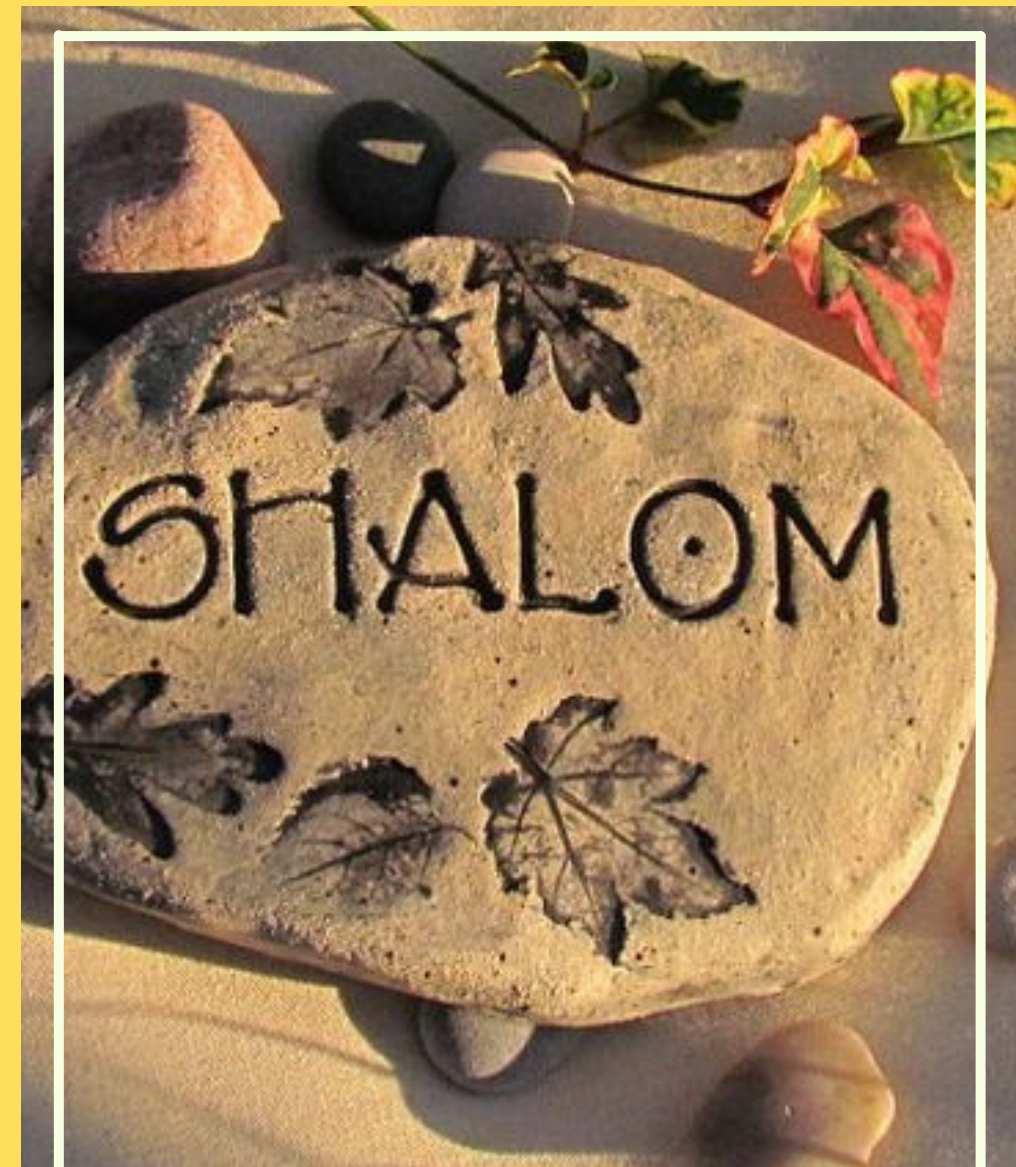

WHAT IS HUMAN TRAFFICKING?

HUMAN TRAFFICKING IS THE TRADE OF HUMANS, MOST COMMONLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF SEXUAL SLAVERY, FORCED LABOUR, OR COMMERCIAL SEXUAL EXPLOITATION FOR THE TRAFFICKER OR OTHERS. SEX TRAFFICKING NOT ONLY RESULTS IN SEVERE VIOLATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS BUT ALSO CAUSE ADVERSE PHYSICAL, PSYCHOLOGICAL AND MORAL CONSEQUENCES FOR THE VICTIMS. IT IS A MULTI-MILLION DOLLAR INDUSTRY, AND HAS CREATED COMPLEX CRIMINAL NETWORKS.

SHALOM MUMBAI MISSION

THIS MISSION WORK STARTED IN 2014 BY MALAYALAM CHURCHES OF MUMBAI UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF C.S.I. MADHYA KERALA DIOCESE. LOTS OF YOUNG GIRLS AND WOMEN ARE TRANSPORTED TO MUMBAI CITY FOR HUMAN TRAFFICKING FROM DIFFERENT VILLAGES OF INDIA. THEY ARE VICTIMISED BECAUSE OF THEIR SOCIAL AND FINANCIAL CONDITIONS. SOME OF THEM ARE INNOCENT VICTIMS OF DECEIT PEOPLE. THE MAJOR CONCERN OF THIS MISSION IS TO RESCUE, REHABILITATE, AND REINTEGRATE VICTIMS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING INTO SOCIETY.

WHAT WE HAVE ACCOMPLISHED?

- Our youth volunteers have partaken in several rescue operations and rescued victims.
- Re-integration of victims with their families under the supervision of Shalom Mission has been done successfully.
- Started a 10 bedded facility with a house mother, counsellor, and caretakers for Major victims. This has been done successfully for a year.
- On partnership with government bodies, we redeveloped Child Welfare Committee (CWC) court in Byculla and Ulhasnagar.
- We also helped in reconstruction of Government Minor Shelter Home Chembur, where many of POCSO victims are admitted.
- We took initiative to start a tailoring unit in Government Major Shelter Home, Chembur and gave 6 tailoring machines.
- Every year we are giving uniforms to children of David Sassoon Juvenile Home, Matunga.
- As part of entrepreneurial project, our inmates in Shalom Niwas made different cloth products and more than 1500 masks during the pandemic, and it's still continuing.
- Conducted awareness programs and workshop for youths of society to end human trafficking and child sex abuse.
- Conducted medical camps for HIV/AIDS infected persons.
- Helped many shelter homes with food, clothes, and skill development programs.
- Acquired 5.8 Acres of land for the further development program. At present we are doing Eco-friendly farming on the acquired land.
- Built visitors room and caretakers' quarters in the acquired land.

- WE DEDICATED THE FOUNDATION STONE FOR 8000 SQ/FT FACILITY IN 25TH DECEMBER 2021 BY OUR PATRON FOR 35+ GIRLS AND WOMEN VICTIMS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING
- RECREATION CENTRE (RENTED PLACE) FOR THE SHALOM MISSION WORKS AT RED-LIGHT AREA.
- STARTING OF FOOD TRUCKS FOR THOSE WHO WILLING TO START A NEW LEAF OF LIVE WHO LEFT RED-LIGHT AREA.
